1.5 Safety Notes

1.5.1 Personal Safety

- Always connect the product to a grounded circuit to avoid the risk of electrocution.
- Keep away from flames and flammable and explosive items.
- For adult use only, keep out of reach of children.
- · Position the machine in a well-ventilated area. Please leave about 50cm spaces surrounding the unit.

1.5.2 Mounting and Rigging

- The machine is not rainproof, please keep dry and do not expose it to rain or humid environment.
- Make sure the ventilation holes on the machine casing are not blocked. If blocked, please clean them in time.
- When hanging at high altitude, use appropriate fixing devices to ensure that it will not fall off or shake accidentally.

1.5.3 Power and Wiring

- Always make sure that the voltage of the outlet to which you are connecting the product is within the range stated on the decal or rear panel of the product.
- Make sure the power cord is not crimped or damaged.
- Never connect this product to a dimmer pack or rheostat.
- Never disconnect the product from the power cord by pulling or tugging on the cord.
- To eliminate unnecessary wear and improve its lifespan, during periods of non-use completely disconnect the product from power via breaker or by unplugging it.

1.5.4 Operation

2 INTRODUCTION

2.1 Description

X-R2 is an upgraded swirl confetti fan from R-2. R-2S uses a powerful fan and innovative wind guide structure to increase the confetti capacity. Confetti scattering time for 3-5 minutes and slowly falling like flowers from


heaven. It creates a warm atmosphere and festivity for ceremony and performance. When hung 10 meters high, the falling confetti can cover a circular area with 10 square meters. The higher it is hung, the better the effect!

2.2 Features


- Power fan and innovative wind guide structure.
- Large confetti capacity can hold 1.5KG confetti.
- Confetti scattering time for 3-5 minutes with wide coverage.
- Confetti is scattered evenly and covers a wide area.

4 SETUP

4.1 AC Power

The machine has a fixed voltage power supply and can work with an input voltage of AC 100-240 V, 50/60 Hz, depending on the specific model.

To determine the product's power requirements (circuit breaker, power outlet, and wiring), use the current value listed on the label affixed to the product's back panel, or refer to the product's specifications chart. The listed current rating indicates the product's average current draw under normal conditions.



Always connect the product to a protected circuit (circuit breaker or fuse). Make sure the product has an appropriate electrical ground to avoid the risk of electrocution or fire.



Never connect the product to a rheostat (variable resistor) or dimmer circuit, even if the rheostat or dimmer channel serves only as a 0 to 100% switch.

4.2 DMX Linking

You can link the X-R2 to a DMX controller using a 3-or 5-pin DMX connection. If using other DMX compatible products with this product, you can control each individually with a single DMX controller Instructions for connecting and configuring this product for DMX operation are in the User Manual.

4.3 Mounting

Before mounting the product, read and follow the safety recommendations indicated in the Safety Notes.

4.3.1 Orientation

Please place the machine flat in a safe location and ensure that there is enough space for ventilation, configuration and maintenance.

4.3.2 Rigging

DJPOWER recommends using the following general guidelines when mounting this product.

- Before deciding on a location for the product, make sure there is easy access to the product for maintenance and programming purposes.
- Make sure that the structure or surface onto which you are mounting the product can support the
 product's weight (see the Technical Specifications).

5 OPERATION

5.1 Preparing for Operation

Before operating the machine, please prepare as follows.

- After checking and confirming that the machine and spare parts are intact, securely mount the machine
 on the truss and hang it for use as needed.
- Place the confetti into the machine's confetti warehouse.
- Insert the power connector firmly into the power socket, confirm the power specifications again, and plug
 the power cord into a grounded socket.

5.2 On-device Control Panel Mode and Operation.

5.2.1 On-device Control Panel

To operate the control panel, use the four buttons below the LCD screen.

5.3 DMX Mode & Operation

X-R2 confetti shot works with a DMX controller

- · Connect the machine to a suitable electrical outlet.
- Open the machine.
- Turn the switch to DMX, and you can control the machine by DMX controller.

After the machine is connected to the DMX, the display scan only display the DMX address setting page, you can set and modify the DMX512 address by pressing the " \blacktriangle " or " \blacktriangledown " keys.

This machine supports 1 DMX channel. The channel table is as follows.
